The Board of Directors meets **once a month**. Board members are elected for a **three-year term** and may be re-elected for a 2nd term. Being a BCAPOP Board member requires a time commitment of **3 to 5 hours per month**. Candidates can be located anywhere in British Columbia as meetings are held virtually.

We are seeking individuals who reflect the broad diversity of our country, and strongly encourage Indigenous people, people of colour, and/or LGBTQIA2S+ folks to apply.
